## **MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

### **Thursday, April 16, 2020**

This regular meeting of the New Market City Council was conducted electronically via a conference call per Section 9 of an additional State Public Health Emergency Declaration issued by Governor Reynolds pertaining to the use of electronic meetings. Each citizen was given the opportunity to participate in this conference call through the information included on the posted meeting agenda as well as the City Website.
